Individual tournaments will follow a tie breaking process for players ending up with tie scores for first, second, and third places. The tie breaker will determine who gets the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place position awards. Based on the positions determined by the tie breaker, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place points will be awarded accordingly. Players ending up with tie scores from 4th place on down will be awarded the same points for the corresponding tied position.

Tie breaking process:

Masters and Prep Series tiebreaker will use the scores on the highest to lowest handicap holes in that order. The tie will be broken as soon as one player has a better score on a hole than the player(s) in the tie.

Pee Wee Series will use a sudden death playoff to determine 1st Place. If two players are tied for first then the winner of the sudden death playoff will be 1st and the other player will be in 2nd place for awards. If more than two players are tied for first place; players with tying scores on a playoff hole will continue to play until no two players are tied. A single player with the highest score on a playoff hole will be eliminated from the playoff and awarded their finishing position according to the number in the playoff. Any ties for second and third will use a putt-off to break these ties.
