Rules and Guidelines

Safety is first –
✓ Listen to the directions of the instructor(s). Swinging a golf club can be dangerous if you are not paying attention to the players around you. Only swing when an instructor gives you permission to do so.
✓ Never move in front of the mats while students are hitting balls. If you need to leave your station for any reason, ask for the instructor's permission.
✓ Be quiet during contests and show respect to other players as they are hitting shots.
✓ To participate in the junior golf league, child must complete the junior golf camp or get approval by instructional staff.
✓ Cursing, bullying, or any inappropriate behavior can result in disciplinary action or expulsion from the program.
